What is it?

Named after the *HMS Sirius*, flagship of the First Fleet, it's a chance for Scouts, Venturers and Leaders to get together with other Scouts at a camp based primarily around water activities.

Events

Camp for the weekend

Canoeing Saturday - Scouts, Venturers and Leader (using a pool of canoes, if you have some add them to the pool)

Canoe Marathon Saturday - will need to bring your own canoe

Canoeing Sunday - Cubs, Scouts and Leader (using a pool of canoes)

Iron man - all ages

Rowing - will need your own rowing boat

Sailing - Saturday afternoon & Sunday morning (will need to bring your boats)

Saturday evening - outdoor movie

Other

All participants need to pre-registration for the Regatta. Registration fees (for camping, activities and event entry) apply to all participants. These are:

Fri-Sun: \$25.00 per person; applies to participants that arrive on Friday and are at the Regatta for the weekend. Includes a badge.

Sat-Sun: \$25.00 per person; applies to participants who attend Saturday and Sunday, whether they stay over or not. Includes a badge.

Sunday: \$12.50 per person; generally the Cubs and leaders who visit on Sunday only. Includes a badge.

Parking: \$40.00 per day (Council parking fee, as at March 2024)

- the car park and surrounding areas have metered parking
